CTI is a signature initiative of the Workforce Skills Cabinet, a collaborative effort between the Executive Offices of Labor and Workforce Development,

Education, and Housing and Economic Development:

- Addresses persistent skills gap that employers face in construction/trades and manufacturing
- Provides opportunity for youth and adults to retrain for skilled occupations especially those hardest hits by COVID
- Transforms vocational high schools into Career Technical Institutes, running three shifts per day to expand enrollment of high school students and adults
- CTI is projected to train 20,000 new skilled workers in key trades and technical jobs as a multi-year strategy
