- Addresses persistent skills gap that employers face in manufacturing and construction/skilled trades
- Provides training to Massachusetts residents who have faced a disconnect from the workforce and require assistance in re-establishing connections to viable job opportunities
- Transforms vocational high schools into Career
 Technical Institutes, running three shifts per day to expand enrollment of adults who are un/underemployed


